MISSION OF THE YWCA

YWCA is dedicated to eliminating racism, empowering women and promoting peace, justice, freedom and dignity for all.

AWARD

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to one female undergraduate or graduate student at ISU. Half of the award will be distributed during the Fall 2019 semester with the other half being distributed during the Spring 2020 semester.

CRITERIA

- Applicant must be a female student who has completed at least one semester at lowa State University prior to Jan. 1, 2019.
- Applicant must demonstrate activity and achievement in one or more areas of the YWCA mission. YWCA membership is **not** required for nomination or selection.
- Applicant must register at Iowa State University for the 2019-2020 academic year.
- Applicant must be in good academic standing with Iowa State University.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Individuals may apply or be nominated. Submit the attached application and other requested information below to the YWCA Executive Director Angela Merrick at amerrick@iastate.edu, or to the YWCA Ames-ISU, 808 Hayward Ave, C1102A Knapp-Storm Commons by 4 p.m. January 31st, 2019.

- Applicant must submit a personal statement describing her activity and achievements relevant to the YWCA mission. She may include copies of news articles, papers, citations, awards and other relevant materials.
- Applicant must submit a one-page resume.
- Applicant must submit a minimum of one (1) letter of support from an individual who can
 describe her commitment to the YWCA mission. An additional letter of support may be
 submitted.

The awards committee will contact applicants or references for additional information if needed.

All completed application materials must be received by 4 p.m. January 31st, 2019.
